Funeral services for Raymond A. Burial will follow in Frazeytsburg Cemetery. Mr. Murray passed away Sunday morning April 30, 2023 at the Altercare of Newark-South. He was born August 15, 1933 in Columbus, OH. Ray retired in 1993 as the Building and Grounds Superintendent at District # 5 ODOT. He had previously served Tri Valley Schools in a similar position. He owned and operated the Artistic Linoleum and Tile Company. He served in the U.S Army during the Korean Conflict.

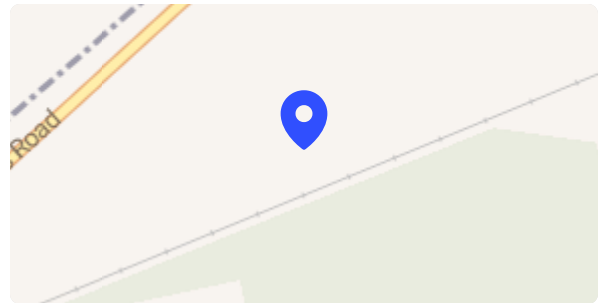
