William F. "Bill" Green, 89, of Frazeytsburg, Ohio died Tuesday evening April 11, 2023 at his home.

Born February 23, 1934 in Boise, Idaho he was a son of the late William F. and Ada (Russell) Green. Bill was a Presbyterian by faith and an active member of the Frazeytsburg Presbyterian Church. He retired from the United States Air Force after twenty years of service and later worked for Conesville AEP as an operations supervisor. He enjoyed watching the Ohio State Buckeyes, the Cincinnati Bearcats, the Cincinnati Reds and the Cincinnati Bengals. Bill was an avid golfer, golfing at least three times a week and hitting two holes-in-one. He was a member of the Dresden American Legion and the NRA.
