# Garland L. "Gary" Williams

JUN 8, 1940 - MAR 13, 2023

**G**arland L. "Gary" Williams, 82, of Frazeytsburg, Ohio died Monday morning, March 13, 2023 at Genesis Hospital Emergency Room in Zanesville, Ohio.

Born June 8, 1940 in Dresden, Ohio he was a son of the late Bryce H. and Maxine (Gray) Williams and was a 1958 graduate of Dresden Jefferson High School. Gary worked for Martin's Dairy and Gene Cox & Sons before co-founding Williams Excavating and Paving of Trinway, Ohio. He was a 4-H advisor and member of the Soil Conservation Association, Muskingum County Sheep Committee, and Dresden Jaycee's. Gary enjoyed golfing and loved spending time with his family.
