Virginia Lee Garver, 92, of Dresden, died Tuesday morning February 7, 2023 at Altercare in Zanesville.

Virginia was a loving homemaker and enjoyed taking and organizing photographs. She spent her winters organizing photo albums. She was a member of the Dresden First Baptist Church for over 40 years.
