Sararose Hewitt, 93, of Newark, died Thursday evening, January 5, 2023 at Licking Memorial Hospital.

Born January 30, 1929 in Hanover Township, Licking County, she was a daughter of the late Grover C. "Bob" and Celia Marie (Hughes) Cartnal and a 1946 graduate of Hanover-Toboso High School. Sararose retired from Newark Family Physicians where she worked in the office for eight years.
