Damian L. "Larry" Wise, 84, of Frazeyburg, Ohio died Sunday morning, July 31, 2022 at The Helen Purcell Care Center in Zanesville, Ohio

Born February 2, 1938 in Sarasota, Florida he was a son of the late Damian and Florence (Neal) Wise. Larry worked in the paving division of Gene Cox & Son Asphalt Company and he was a self-employed plasterer. He was a private pilot and loved to travel.
