Marjorie F. Staggers Westbrook, 95, of Nashport, Ohio died morning, June 3, 2022 at her home.

Born August 13, 1926 in Perry Township of Licking County she was a daughter to the late John T. Staggers and Edna Jane Nethers Staggers Tish. Marjorie was a 1944 graduate of Hanover-Toboso High School and was a member of the Coshocton Church of God. She was a longtime member of the Missionary Society of the church. Over the years she worked at the Black Run Grocery Store, Essex Wire Company in Zanesville and in the office of Hanover Farmer's Exchange, as well as being a homemaker. Marjorie was a very faithful friend and neighbor and truly enjoyed sending cards of every occasion to people of the community.

Surviving is one son, Gary (Sherry) Westbrook of Millersburg, Ohio; two daughters, Yvonne Mitchell and Amy (Todd) Gibson, both of Nashport; seven grandchildren and twelve great grandchildren.
