# Sharon Lou Tannehill

**S**haron Lou Chapman Tannehill, 78, of Parma Heights, Ohio, formerly of Nashport, Ohio died Tuesday evening, May 3, 2022 at University Hospital in Parma, Ohio.

Born April 21, 1944 in Mineral Wells, Texas, she was a daughter of the late Allen W. “Chippy” and Flora “Faye” (Marsden) Chapman. Sharon was a 1962 graduate of Frazeyburg High School and she received an Associate Degree in Early Childhood Education from Cuyahoga Community College.
