James C. Fleming, 87, of Marne, Ohio died Sunday afternoon, April 3, 2022 at The Oaks at Northpointe in Zanesville, Ohio.

Born January 11, 1935 in Frazeytsburg, Ohio, he was a son of the late Thomas C. Fleming, Sr. and Rhoda Margaret (Lecky) Fleming. James was a 1953 graduate of Frazeytsburg High School and he proudly served our country as a member of the United States Marines during the Korean War. He retired in 1997 from Rockwell International where he was a pipefitter in the maintenance department. James was a member of Marne United Methodist Church; New Home Lodge #338, F. & A. M. and Hanover American Legion. He loved golfing and he was a wonderful husband, father, grandfather and great grandfather.
