## Mary Jo Hatfield

DEC 1, 1944 - JAN 5, 2022

**M**ary Jo Hatfield, 77, of Adamsville, died peacefully at her home, Wednesday evening, January 5, 2022.

Born December 1, 1944, she was a daughter of the late Elmer Ray and Mary E. (Quinn) Helriggle and was a 1962 graduate of Adamsville High School. Mary Jo worked as a nurse's aide at Adams Lane Care Center for over 20 years and a faithful member of the Adamsville United Methodist Church. Birthdays were special for Mary Jo and she made sure to acknowledge everyone's that she could remember. On your birthday she either woke you up with a 3:00 am phone call, or a cowbell or firecrackers outside your bedroom window. She will be remembered for her pie baking, black magic marker and piercing ears with an ice cube and a needle for almost every little girl in Adamsville. In the summers, she would have six at a time lined up on the picnic table, the youngest being her granddaughter at three days old.
