Robert Mark “Bun” McClure, 64, of Dresden, died Tuesday evening, January 4, 2022 at Genesis Hospital, Zanesville.

Born February 9, 1957 in Zanesville, a son of the late Robert M. and Reva (Spiker) McClure and a 1975 Tri-Valley High School graduate. Bun retired after 42 years of service from the Norfolk Southern Railroad as a signal maintainer. He was a Methodist by faith and a member of the Sons of the American Legion Post #399.
