## Joseph "Joe" F. Randall

**J**oseph F. "Joe" Randall, 68, of Frazeytsburg, Ohio died Thursday afternoon, December 23, 2021, at Genesis Hospital Emergency Department in Zanesville.

Born July 7, 1953 in Zanesville he was a son of the late George F. and Helene A. (Kover) Randall and was a 1971 graduate of Tri-Valley High School. Joe was a retired heavy equipment operator working from the International Union of Operating Engineers Local Union 18 of Columbus, Ohio and he was a member of Perryton United Methodist Church.

Joe was a very avid sports fan and he loved the Ohio State Buckeyes. But if you even knew Joe a little, you knew that he was one of Tri-Valley High School's biggest and greatest fans. Joe was a member of the Tri-Valley 12th Man Club, the Tri-Valley Boosters Club and, for many years, was a member of the Tri-Valley Football "Chain Gang". No matter what, home or away, no matter the sport, you could almost always find Joe in the crowd, many times wearing his 1971 Varsity jacket, cheering on the team.
