Dale A. Norman, 68, of Frazeytsburg, Ohio died Saturday morning, December 4, 2021 at Riverside Hospital in Columbus, Ohio.

Born March 27, 1953 in Zanesville, Ohio, he was the son of the late Robert D. and Eva M. (Miller) Norman and was a 1971 graduate of Tri-Valley High School. Dale was an electrician and was retired from Goodin Electric, Inc. of Newark, Ohio.
