Beatrice Ann Blizzard, 93, formerly of Frazeytsburg, Ohio died Friday, September 24, 2021 in Indiana, where she has been residing with her daughter.

Born September 5, 1928 in Zanesville, Ohio she was a daughter of the late Carl R. and Eleanor Beatrice Eppley. Following high school, she was educated at Muskingum College and became an elementary school teacher. During her career she taught at Dillon Elementary, Frazeytsburg Elementary and Newark Road Christian Academy. Bea was a devout Christian and attended Frazeytsburg United Methodist Church, Frazeytsburg Community Bible Church, Zanesville Christian Missionary Alliance Church, Meadow View Church of Christ in Frazeytsburg and Christ Church North in Noblesville, Indiana. She enjoyed reading, needle work, volunteer church work, table games, crossword puzzles and bowling and most of all, her family.
