Ron loved to sing and play the guitar and performed with many different choirs and musical ensembles. In college he performed the role of Count Almaviva in Mozart's "The Marriage of Figaro" and Captain Corcoran in Gilbert and Sullivan's "HMS Pinafore".

A memorial service will be 11:00 A.M. Tuesday, May 25, 2021 at Newark Seventh Day Adventist Church (where Ron was a member) with Elder Leon Brown officiating. An additional memorial service is being planned for sometime in the future in Pennsylvania.
