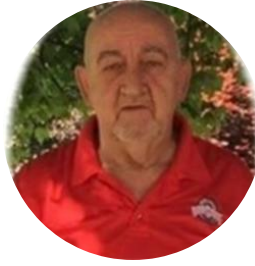

Gary Dale Dillon, 75, of Granville, Ohio died Tuesday morning, May 4, 2021 at his home.

Born January 30, 1946 in Newark, Ohio he was a son of the late John Dillon, Jr. and Ollie Mae (Cline) Dillon. Gary was a 1964 graduate of Frazeytsburg High School and he proudly served our country in Vietnam as a member of the United States Army. He was a truck driver and retired in 2008 after 36 years of driving for Advanced Transfer and Newark Electro Plating.
