Mabel V. Pethtel, 97, formerly of Hanover, Ohio died peacefully at her home in Nashport, Ohio Saturday morning, April 24, 2021. She was affectionately known by many as “Granny”.

Born June 9, 1923 in Deep Valley, Pennsylvania she was a daughter of the late John A. and Nevada (Miller) Strosnider. She was the youngest of nine children. During World War II she worked at National Electric Company in Ambridge, Pennsylvania as an inspector, but she spent most of her life as a homemaker. Mabel was a member of the Methodist faith.
