Jeremy M. Brennen, 42, of Dresden, Ohio died Thursday evening, February 25, 2021 at his home after a courageous battle with cancer.

Born September 2, 1978 in Zanesville, Ohio he was the son of Judy (Richard) Goetz and the late Michael Brennen and was a 1996 graduate of Tri-Valley High School. He received his associate degree from MATC and his bachelor's degree from Mount Vernon Nazarene University then worked in accounting for several area businesses.

Jeremy was extremely active in the community and Protestant by faith. In his youth, he was a long-time member of 4-H, active in the Dresden United Methodist Church Youth Group and in the TVHS German Club. Jeremy was a wonderful, but reluctant piano player.
