Shane D. McClellan, 45, of Toboso, Ohio died Sunday, January 31, 2021 at his home.

Shane was a 1993 graduate of Newark Catholic High School where he was a member of the football team and the wrestling team. For the past 28 years Shane has worked at Holophane of Newark where he was a glass inspector. He was a member of Toboso United Methodist Church and the United Steelworkers Union Local #525.
