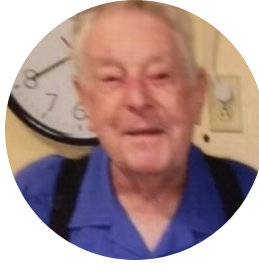

Charles “Charlie” Llewelyn Courson, 85 of Newark passed away December 23, 2020 at The Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center with his family at his side.

Born September 28, 1935 in Newark to the late Charles and Fern (Kaylor) Courson. Charlie retired from OSU-Newark after 32 years. He attended Heath Christian Union Church. He was an active member of Newark Eagles #387. The three things that mattered most to Charlie were God, his country and his family. He spent his life helping others through charitable work with the Eagles and Salvation Army. He passed this passion on to his family and his legacy will live through them.
