Paul E. Rector, 93, of Nashport, Ohio died Sunday morning, November 29, 2020 at his home.

Born March 21, 1927 in Hanover, Ohio he was a son of the late Robert “Bert” and Bessie E. (McGinnis) Rector and was a 1944 graduate of Hanover High School. Following high school Paul proudly served our country in the United States Army during World War II. He retired in 1972 from the Pennsylvania/Penn Central Railroad where he was a brakeman/conductor. Paul was a member of Meadow View Church of Christ in Frazeytsburg and he had previously been a member of both Perryton Church of Christ and Licking Valley Church of Christ. He was a member of the Muskingum Valley Old Timers Baseball Association of Zanesville and he was very active in Youth League Baseball in the Frazeytsburg-Dresden area for many years.
