**J**an V. Schneider, 83, of Dresden, Ohio died Tuesday morning, November 17, 2020 at his home.

Born June 1, 1937 in West Virginia, he was a son of the late Paul and Kathleen (Stump) Schneider and he attended The Ohio State University. Jan retired from Rockwell International after 29 years of service. He was a former member of the Dresden Presbyterian Church and he attended Trinway United Methodist Church. Jan was a 4-H advisor with Riverside 4-H of Dresden for 50 years. He was a lifetime member of the Old Steam and Gas Club of Dresden as well as the NRA.
