A private family funeral service for Phyllis Sue Britton, 66 of Newark will be held at Forest Lawn Memorial Gardens in Columbus with Pastor Scott Campbell officiating.

Mrs. Britton passed away on Tuesday, October 13, 2020 at Brookdale Assisted Living in Mt. Vernon. She was born July 22, 1954 in Columbus to the late Lawrence and Letty (Strawser) Perry.

She retired in 2007 from State Farm Insurance as a Claims Service Assistant with 25 years of service. Sue was a 1972 graduate of Sheridan High School and received an Associate Degree from COTC in 1989. She was a member of Newark First United Methodist Church.
