William “Bill” Seth Ripple, 86, of Dresden, Ohio died Friday evening September 11, 2020 at his home.

Born February 24, 1934 in Dresden he was a son of the late Charles John and Pansy Pauline (Paynter) Ripple and was a 1952 graduate of Dresden Jefferson High School.
