Leonard Gene Smith, 92, of Frazeytsburg, Ohio died Wednesday afternoon, July 29, 2020 in the emergency department of Genesis Hospital in Zanesville, Ohio.

Born June 21, 1928 in Zanesville he was a son of the late Leonard E. and Isabelle (Deal) Smith and was a 1946 graduate of Lash High School. Following high school he proudly served our country as a member of the United States Marine Corps and was a member of Wakatomika Post 6193, VFW of Frazeytsburg. Leonard helped to establish the Frazeytsburg Community Bible Church and was very active in the church, having held many leadership roles over the years. He was retired from Armco Steel of Zanesville after 30 years of service. He also worked with his son at Olde Village Meats of Frazeytsburg and he operated Smith's Car Wash of Frazeytsburg for many years.

Surviving is his loving wife of 69 years, Dorothy E. (Ashcraft) Smith whom he married October 8, 1950; two sons, Michael D. Smith of Nashport and Jeffrey (KC) Smith of Frazeytsburg; four grandchildren, Adam Smith, David (Kayela) Smith, Matthew (Abby) Smith and Ali Smith and one great grandchild, Kyiah Smith. Also surviving is one brother, Charles Smith of Lancaster, Ohio; two sisters, Madeline Shaver of Zanesville and Janice Willis of South Carolina and several nieces and nephews.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by a brother Ron Smith.
