A memorial service for Raymond B. Miller, 82 of Newark will be held at 5:00 p.m. on Thursday June 25, 2020 at the Licking Valley Church of Christ, 1578 Dayton Road NE, Newark with Gus Andrews officiating. A visitation will be held from 4:00 p.m. until time of service at the church.

Mr. Miller passed away on Monday June 22, 2020 at the Selma Markowitz Care Center operated by Hospice of Central Ohio. He was born September 9, 1937 in Newark to Carl and Georgia (Bennett) Miller.

Mr. Miller was a 1955 graduate of Newark High School. He retired after 26 ½ years at Dow Chemical. While with Dow, he traveled to France to establish a facility.
