Robert D. "Bob" Norman, 95, of Frazeytsburg, Ohio died Thursday morning, June 4, 2020 at his home.

Born February 19, 1925 in Frazeytsburg he was a son of the late Logan and Pearl (Powers) Norman and was a 1943 graduate of Frazeytsburg High School. He retired in 1987 from Armco Steel of Zanesville where he worked for 39 years. Bob was a member of the Frazeytsburg United Methodist Church and he enjoyed hunting, trapping and farming.

Surviving is one son, Dale (Anzil) Norman of Frazeytsburg; one daughter, Virginia King of Frazeytsburg and several loving grandchildren and great grandchildren. Also surviving is one great great grandchild and several nieces and nephews.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his loving wife of 71 years, Eva M. (Miller) Norman whom he married March 12, 1948 and who died October 12, 2019; one brother, Homer Norman and three sisters, Opal Gould, Edith McPeck and Helen Croy.
