Bernice L. Whyde, 93, of Dresden, Ohio died Monday evening, April 20, 2020 at Genesis Hospital in Zanesville, Ohio.

Mrs. Whyde was a homemaker and was also a former of employee of Essex Wire Company and Social Supper Company. Bernice loved children and she provided care for pre-school children for many years. She attended North Terrace Church of Christ and was a member of the Dresden American Legion Ladies Auxiliary.
