Marion E. "Gene" Larry, 89, of Newark, Ohio died Monday afternoon, March 16, 2020 at Chestnut House in Newark.

Born January 7, 1931 in Perryton, Ohio he was a son of the late Paul and Alta Doris (Frampton) Larry and was a 1948 graduate of Frazeytsburg High School. Mr. Larry was a Chief Warrant Officer with the Ohio National Guard where he served for 40 years. He also served our country during the Korean War. Gene was a member of Neil Avenue United Methodist Church in Newark and was a former member of the Amrou Grotto and the Coachman Camper Club. He enjoyed new cars, especially Corvettes.
