Christopher J. “Chris” Holland, 46, of Nashport, Ohio passed away unexpectedly on Sunday, January 26, 2020.

Born November 6, 1973 in Zanesville, Ohio, he was the son of Larry and Betty (Newell) Holland of Trinway, Ohio and was a 1992 graduate of Tri-Valley High School. He was also a 2013 graduate of Zane State College with a degree mechanical engineering, and a 2019 graduate of Mount Vernon Nazarene University where he received his bachelor’s degree in business. Chris was a basket maker and pivotal member of the ergonomic team at The Longaberger Company. Later, he owned and operated his own construction company, Titan Construction. His most recent accomplishment was that of being the President of Malta Dynamics where he thrived on keeping others safe in many industries and where he was also a Z359 ANSI board member.
