**A** funeral service for Evenes M. "Eve" Koppert, 95 of Newark will be held at 10:30 a.m. Friday January 3, 2020 in the sanctuary of First United Methodist Church, 88 N. Fifth Street with Pastor Scott Campbell and Pastor Todd Frail officiating. Burial will be in Cedar Hill Cemetery.

Mrs. Koppert died Tuesday December 31, 2019 in Mt. Carmel East Medical Center. She was born June 7, 1924 in Newark to John M. and Vera (Mitchell) Stanley.

She was a 1942 graduate of Newark High School, having received the highest grades of her class. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church since 1943. She served as the church secretary for 25 years. She was active in the Candlelighters, UMW and a reliable kitchen worker. She read her Bible regularly even as her eye sight failed. She kept current contacts for prayer needs in the congregation. Throughout her life she enjoyed nature, taking great pleasure in flowers and walks.
