Roger L. Cozzens, 69, of Hanover, Ohio died Friday evening, November 29, 2019 at his home with his loving family at his side.

Roger was a 1968 graduate of Licking Valley High School and was a self-employed building contractor, retiring in 2017. He was also a delivery driver for Chester Flowers Marathon for over 20 years.
