Norman E. Shepler, 94, of Frazeytsburg, Ohio died Saturday afternoon, November 2, 2019 at Genesis Hospital in Zanesville.

Born July 12, 1925 in Franklin Township of Coshocton County, he was a son of the late William P. and Agnes B. (McVickers) Shepler. Mr. Shepler proudly served our county in the United States Navy during World War II. He worked for Ohio Pipeline for 28 years and then he was self-employed for 12 years as owner and operator of Shepler Trucking. Norman was also a farmer and he loved the outdoors, hunting and fishing. He enjoyed spending time with his grandchildren and watching sports on TV.

Surviving is his loving wife of 70 years, Amy J. (Evans) Shepler whom he married November 14, 1949; two sons, James A. (Vickie) Shepler of Frazeytsburg and Jeff (Marg) Shepler of Nashport; one daughter, Norma (Art) Girton of Frazeytsburg; a daughter in-law, Maggie Shepler of Newark; ten grandchildren; eighteen great grandchildren; one great great grandchild and several nieces and nephews.
