Ray Thompson, Jr., 93, of Nashport, Ohio died Friday morning, March 22, 2019 at his home.

Born March 13, 1926 in Zanesville, Ohio he was a son of the late Roy G. and Sylvia (Adams) Thompson. Mr. Thompson proudly served our country in the U. S. Marine Corp during World War II. He was a retired truck driver having worked for over 30 years with B. & L. Motor Freight and later Hanby Farms. Ray was a member of the Nashport-Irville United Methodist Church.

Surviving is his loving wife of over 72 years, Anna Mae (Kendall) Thompson whom he married October 19, 1946; a daughter, Deborah Weber of Zanesville, Ohio; seven grandchildren; sixteen great grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.
