## **Hazel R. Williams**

JUN 18, 1919 - JAN 23, 2019

**H**azel R. Williams, 99, of Frazeytsburg, Ohio died Wednesday morning, January 23, 2019 at Adams Lane Care Center in Zanesville, Ohio.

Born June 18, 1919 in Dresden, Ohio she was a daughter of the late Russell and Janie (Birkhimer) Swope and was a 1937 graduate of Dresden Jefferson High School. Mrs. Williams was a member of the Frazeytsburg United Methodist Church and enjoyed reading and gardening. She was a former employee of the Ohio Plastics Company of Frazeytsburg.

Surviving is one daughter, Roberta Tapley of Topeka, Kansas; six grandchildren; several great grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.
