**S**tella M. Booth Gomez, 85, of Frazeytsburg, Ohio died Monday morning, December 3, 2018 at her home.

Born May 26, 1933 in Ashland, Kentucky she was a daughter of the late Jay and Ethel (Lemons) Evans and was a 1951 graduate of Hanover High School. She was a member of Perry Chapel Baptist Church. Stella worked as a waitress for many years at L & K Restaurant and worked banquets at Howard Johnston's and Licking County Trout Club. She also worked at Ohio Plastics in Frazeytsburg. Stella enjoyed flower gardening, flea markets and antiques.
