Frances M. Berry, 90, of Dresden, Ohio died Friday morning, November 16, 2018 at Genesis Morrison House in Zanesville, Ohio.

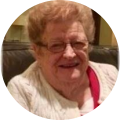
Born January 7, 1928 in Killbuck, Ohio she was a daughter of the late Willis and Bessie (Pyers) Shroyer. Frances was a member of St. Ann Catholic Church in Dresden and a member of the American Legion Ladies Auxiliary.
