Eugene J. Riley, 98, of Dresden, formerly of Frazeyburg, Ohio died peacefully Saturday morning, July 28, 2018 at Primrose Retirement Community in Zanesville, Ohio.

Born December 8, 1919 in Frazeyburg, he was a son of the late Armour J. and Bessie (Johnston) Riley and was a 1936 graduate of Frazeyburg High School. He was an Army veteran who served two years overseas during World War II. Eugene was a member of Wakatomika Post 6193, VFW in Frazeyburg and a life time member of the Frazeyburg Presbyterian Church. He was a lifelong farmer and he retired from Rockwell International of Heath, Ohio with 25 years of service.

Surviving are his two sons, Steve Riley of Columbus, Indiana and Tim (Maureen) Riley of Ann Arbor, Michigan; four grandchildren, Tracy (Jason) McKeown, Betsy (Tim) Burke, John Riley and Brenna Riley; six great grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his wife, Irene (Shrimplin) Riley whom he married March 8, 1943 and who died February 8, 2015; two sisters, Alice L. Riley and Helen V. Stickel and three brothers, Frank S., James W. and Joseph M. Riley.
