Mildred Moran Gray, 92, of Adams Mills, Ohio died at noon, Sunday, July 8, 2018 at Genesis Morrison House in Zanesville, Ohio

Born May 2, 1926 in Jackson Township of Muskingum County she was a daughter of the late Carl and Hazel (Ashcraft) Moran and was a 1944 graduate of Frazeyburg High School. For many years she was a member of Madison Presbyterian Church in Adams Mills and she served the church as an Elder, a trustee and its clerk. Currently she was a member of Dresden Madison Presbyterian Church in Dresden. Mildred was a former employee of the Longaberger Company where she worked in Guest Relations.
