Pauline Staugh, 82, of Newark, Ohio died Thursday morning, June 7, 2018 at Arlington Nursing Home in Newark.

Born April 10, 1936 in Frazeytsburg, Ohio she was the daughter of the late Wilbur H. McDonald and Eleanor (Blizzard) McDonald Sidle. Mrs. Staugh was a retired school bus driver with 25 years of service at Licking Valley Schools. She enjoyed cooking and being with her family.

Surviving is one son, Fred (Patti) Staugh of Cedar Rapids, Iowa; four daughters, Sharon (Steven) Brown of Palm Bay, Florida, Kathy Harris of Newark, Connie (Frank) Zeman of Nashport and Kimberly (Russ) Hammer of Newark; nine grandchildren and twenty-three great grandchildren and several cousins.
