# Richard "Fuzzy" Harding

**R**ichard Lee "Fuzzy" Harding, 72, of Zanesville, Ohio died Monday morning, April 16, 2018 at Genesis Hospital in Zanesville.

Born March 1, 1946 in Zanesville, Ohio he was a son of the late James R. and Effie Ellen (Wolfe) Harding. He was a retired coal miner having worked for Peabody Coal Company and later, Sunny Hill Coal Company. He had also worked for Owens-Corning and both Merriam Roofing and Browns Roofing of Adamsville. Mr. Harding was member of the UMWA, the Eagles Lodge #302 of Zanesville, where he was a former trustee, and the American Legion Post #29 of Zanesville He enjoyed collecting Hot Wheels, marbles and knives.

Surviving is one son Daniel (Clayton Reed) Harding of Zanesville; one daughter, Eyvette (Clem, Jr.) Dunlap of Zanesville; two grandchildren, Kara Dunlap and Kyle Dunlap; one brother, Terry (Janie) Harding of Nashport, Ohio; four sisters, Betty (Larry) Shanks of Zanesville, JoAnn (Doug) Joy of Blacksburg, South Carolina, Brenda (Craig) Foster and Barb Miller, both of Norwich, Ohio.
