William H. "Bill" Wagner, 82, of Frazeytsburg, Ohio died Thursday evening, April 5, 2018 at The Oaks at Northpointe in Zanesville, Ohio.

Born October 29, 1935 near Zanesville, he was a son of the late Walter Everett and Helen (Sensibaugh) Wagner. Mr. Wagner attended the Dresden United Methodist Church. Bill was a farmer and a retired self-employed truck driver. He also worked several years for Cass Township of Muskingum County. His hobby was working and taking care of his farm.
