## Jefferey W. Sensabaugh

JUL 29, 1941 - JAN 19, 2018

**J**efferey W. Sensabaugh, 76, of Dresden, Ohio died Friday afternoon, January 19, 2018 at the home of his daughter, Amy Hupp, in Coshocton, Ohio.

Born July 29, 1941 in Newark, Ohio he was a son of the late Frederick and Mary Ellen (Hoy) Sensabaugh and was a 1959 graduate of Dresden Jefferson High School. Following high school he proudly served our country as a member of the United States Air Force. Mr. Sensabaugh retired in 2005 from the Holophane Company of Newark. He was a member and former president of the IBEW Union Local 1853 at Holophane.

Surviving are four daughters, Amy (Edward) Hupp of Coshocton, Dara (Scott) Wagner of Dresden, Dedra (Scott) Sines of Dallastown, Pennsylvania and Kelley (Steve) Frye of Coshocton; thirteen grandchildren and nine great grandchildren.
