## **William "Bill" Nethers**

**W**illiam E. "Bill" Nethers, 79, of Newark, Ohio died peacefully, surrounded by his loving family, Tuesday morning, October 31, 2017 at Riverside Hospital in Columbus, Ohio.

Born November 22, 1937 in Perry Township of Licking County, he was a son of the late Charles E. and Margaret M. (Rogers) Nethers and he attended Hanover-Toboso High School. Mr. Nethers was a retired maintenance supervisor with Bowerston Shale Company of Hanover and was a member of the Coshocton Church of God.
