Born December 29, 1920 in Barnes Run, West Virginia she was a daughter of the late George Coleman and Alma Estella (Smith) Connolly and was a 1939 graduate of Frazeytsburg High School. Mrs. Ludinich was a homemaker and a member of St. Ann Catholic Church in Dresden, St. Ann Catholic Women's Association and the Fifty Club of Frazeytsburg. She enjoyed reading, doing crossword puzzles, canning and freezing the produce from her garden and supporting and providing for her loving family.
