A funeral service for Amber D. Johnson, 51 of Newark will be 1:00 p.m. Tuesday, October 24, 2017 in the Newark Chapel of Vensil & Chute Funeral Home with Pastor Jim Young officiating. Burial will be in Wilson Cemetery.

Amber died suddenly October 18, 2017 at Licking Memorial Hospital. She was born November 19, 1965 in Columbus, OH. A graduate of Newark High School and she attended COTC; Amber was a devoted mother and caretaker.
