Larry Lloyd Hindel, 91, of Frazeyburg, Ohio died peacefully Monday morning, September 4, 2017 at Genesis Hospital, Zanesville, Ohio. His loving family was at his side.

Born May 10, 1926 in Dresden, Ohio he was a son of the late Joseph D. and Mary E. (Luckett) Hindel. Larry had a great love for our country and proudly served in the U. S. Navy during World War II and was inducted into the Muskingum County Veterans Hall of Fame. He was a member of the Washington Township Baptist Church and Wakatomika Post 6139, V. F. W. of Frazeyburg. Larry was a passionate man who loved his family and his country and he enjoyed giving and helping his friends.

Surviving is a son and daughter in-law, Larry Wayne and Brenda Hindel of Dresden; two grandchildren, Laura (Adam) Seward and Russell (Danielle) Hindel; four great grandchildren, Aedin, Renae and Mason Seward and Havana Hindel; a brother, James F.
