Charles R. Robison, 85, of Frazeytsburg, Ohio died Wednesday morning, August 2, 2017 at his home.

Born April 18, 1932 in Cass Township, Muskingum County, he was a son of the late Ralph S. Robison, Sr. and Susan (McGinnis) Robison. Charles was a 1950 graduate of Frazeytsburg High School and he proudly served our country in the U. S. Marines during the Korean War. He retired in 1992 from Owens-Corning Fiberglas where he was a machine tender. He was a member of the Frazeytsburg United Methodist Church; Wakatomika Post #6193, VFW of Frazeytsburg; Frazeytsburg Lodge #490, F. & A. M. and was a former member of the Frazeytsburg Volunteer Fire Department.

Surviving is his loving wife of 66 years, Lila Lee (Riley) Robison whom he married March 12, 1951; one son, Steven M. (Linda) Robison of Dresden, Ohio; one daughter, Marty A. (Graham Trainer) Chaney of Granville, Ohio; four grandchildren, Kenny (Natalie) Chaney, Laura (John) Sines, Beth (Jason) Braddock and Charles Robison; nine great grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.
