**M**arcelene H. Cooper, 93, of Dresden, Ohio died Sunday afternoon, February 12, 2017 at Primrose Retirement Community of Zanesville.

Born September 20, 1923 in Muskingum Township of Muskingum County, she was a daughter of the late Joseph W. and Martha F. (Watt) Harper and was a 1941 graduate of Dresden Jefferson High School. Mrs. Cooper was a life-long resident of Muskingum Township and a member of Muskingum Presbyterian Church. She was a homemaker and assisted her late husband in the operation of their family farm, a job she truly enjoyed. Her greatest enjoyment was being with her family.
