A funeral service for Alvie W. "Bill" Lampton, 84 of Mt. Mr. Lampton died Sunday January 29, 2017 at the Thornville Health and Rehabilitation Center. He was born July 4, 1932 in Hopewell Twp., Licking Co. to the late Irville E. and Mildred E. (White) Lampton.
